Ministry of Railways (Railway Board), after consulting Department of Personnel & Training (DoP&T), Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions have decided that the technical officials concerned with administration of the tournaments will not be treated as part of the team but will be given the facility of availing of Special Casual Leave for a period not exceeding 30 days in a calendar year as is admissible in the case of persons covered in para 1(iii) to (vii) of the Department of Personnel & Training (DoP&T)'s O.M. No. 6/1/85-Estt.(Pay -I) dated 16.07.1985 (copy enclosed) read with DoP&T's O.M. No. 6/1/85-Estt.(Pay -I) dated 07.11.1988 (copy enclosed). This will also cover their attending the pre-selection trials/camp connected with sporting events of national/international importance.

Subject: - Participation by Central Government Servants in sperting events and tournaments of national or international importance.

Central Government Special casual leave is granted to 30 days in any one calendar year for

- participating in sporting events of national/ international importance; (11)
- coaching/administration of teams participating in sporting events of national/international importance; (111)
- attending coaching or training camps under Rajkumari Amrit Kaur Coaching Scheme or similar All India Coaching or Training Schemes; (1v)
- attending coaching or training camps at the National Institute of Sports, Patiala; (v)
- participating in mountaineering expedictions; (vi)
- attending coaching camps in sports organised by National Sports Federation Sports Boards recognised by All India Council of Sports; and
- (TIV) participating in trekking expeditions;
- Special Casual Leave is also granted to Central Government servants for a period not exceeding 10 days in any one calendar year for participating in inter-ministerial and inter-departmental tournaments and sporting events

is pleased to decide as foll. ws:-

- In the case of Central Government servants who are selected for participating in sporting events of national/international importance, the period of the actual days on which they participate in the events as also the time spent in travelling to and from such tournaments may be treated as duty. Further, if any pro-participation Coaching Camp is held in connect with the above mentioned events and the Government servant is required to attend the same, this period may also be treated as on duty. Consequently, the existing provisions regarding grant of Special Casual leave for the purposes mentioned in this item may be treated as cancelled. item may be treated as cancelled.
- The quantum of Special Casual leave for a period not exceeding 30 days in a Calendar year allowed to Central Covernment employees, for purposes indicated at items (iii) to (vii) in para 1 above, will account the state of the s will cover also their attending the pro-solection trials/camps connected with sporting events of na' lonal/international importance.
 - The Central Government employees who are selecte for participating in sporting events of national/ international importance within India, may be allowed to travel by First Class by train. In the case of events of international importance held outside India, they may be entitled to trave
 - (iv Xa) The number of increments to be awarded for achieving excellence in National events should laid down at a scale lower than for excellance in International events, say one increment for Nationallogant and two increments for Internationa events.
 - The total number of increments to be awarded to an individual should not exceed five in Whis/her entire carper.
 - The increments so granted would continue to be drawn at the same rate fill retirement and would count for the purpose of retirement benefits but not for pay fixation on promotion on the analogy of incentive increments awarded for proporting small family norms in Lington (1985)

The President is now pleased to decide that the rate of personal pay in respect of pleased to decide that the rate of personal pay in receipt those Central Government employees who were already in receipt of personal pay prior to 1.1.86 in terms of the provisions contained in the aforesaid 0.M. will be an amount equivalent to the tained in the aforesaid 0.M. will be an amount equivalent to the lowest rate of increment in the revised scale corresponding to the pay scale of the post against which the individual had earn-the pay scale of the post against which the individual had earn-ed the personal pay in the pre-revised scales of pay and they will be allowed the same number of increments in the revised scale as had been allowed in the pre-revised scale.

3. The question of clarifying certain provisions contained in this Department's O.M. dated 16.7.85 and also providing for this Department's O.M. dated 16.7.85 and also providing for certain further incentives/facilities has been examined by the Covernment and in this connection the following decisions have Government, and in this connection the following decisions have been taken:

(1) Para 1(vi) of this Department's 0.M of even number. dated 16.7.85 may be read as follows:-

(vi) Attending coaching camps in sports organised by National Sports Federations/Sports Boards recognised by Government (Department of Youth Affairs & Sports)".

For the purpose of availing the facilities mentioned in the O.M. referred to above, National Championships being conducted by the recognised National Sports Féderations in individual disciplines and National Games conducted by Indian Olympic Association should be recognised as events of national importance.

- iii) For the purpose of availing the facilities mentioned in the 0.M. quoted above, the events recognised by the International Sports podies in the concerned disciplines and in which participation has been with the prior approval of the Obvernment (Department of Youth Affairs Sports) may be treated as sporting events of international importance.
 - Managers/Coaches/Masseurs/Doctors as may be approved or required by the Federations under rules to administer/Coach/manage the teams participation in sports events of National/International importance may be treated as an integral part of the teams and these officials may also be allowed the same facilities as are available to sports persons for such participation except that the question of grant of rewards in the form of advance increments could be considered on merits, if and when sponsored by the Departments concerned. However, the technical officials concerned with the administration of the tournaments will not be treated as part of the teams but will be given the facilities of availing of special capual leave as is administration to the teams but will be given the facilities of availing of special capual leave as is administration to (vii) of this Department's O.M. of even number dated 16.7.85.
 - (v) The sports-persons from the All India Civil services Sports Control Board attending coaching camps and participating in various All India Civil Services sporting events are also covered under the O.M. with a view to giving them the facilities of special casual leave.
 - (vi) Para 3(iv) (c) of this Department's 0.M. of eyer number dated 16.7.85 may be read as follows:
 - "(iv)(c) The increments so granted would comnue to be drawn at the same rate till
